We are very pleased to have you at the **Sweet Tea Challenge** tournament hosted by *Hype Nation*. This packet should contain all the information you need to compete in this year's event. Please be sure to read everything very carefully as we will not have a coaches' meeting prior to playing on Saturday.

#### **SCHEDULES:**

#### **TEAM CHECK-IN:**

Teams can check-in at the facility any time before their first match on **Saturday**, **January 13**. Please allow enough time to purchase your tickets & enter the facility. **If you have not loaded your roster into AES by Thursday**, **please bring a signed copy for check-in**.

One member will be allowed to check-in all teams and pick up the coach's wristbands.

#### **VENUE:**

#### **Finley Center**

5508 Stadium Trace Parkway, Hoover, AL, 35244

#### **PARKING:**

There is plenty of parking available at the facility. Parking will be free for the weekend. **Do not park in the fire lanes and do not park illegally. Violators will be towed at the owner's expense.** 

#### **WRISTBANDS:**

The ticketing program only allows us to scan the ticket one time so do <u>NOT</u> take your wristband off for any reason. If you take it off or lose it, you will be charged for a new wristband. No exceptions.



#### TICKETS:

All spectators 11 & up will need a wristband, 10 & under are free. Coaches will receive a wristband at check-in (2 coaches maximum. No chaperones/team representatives). Prices will be \$36.16 for the weekend \$15.49 for a day pass. Credit Card payments only will be accepted, **no cash**. Please allow enough time to purchase your tickets & enter the facility. You can pre-purchase your tickets at the link below.

\*Tickets purchased online will include an additional 10% credit card fee. Tickets purchased at the venue will not include this fee.

# **SEATING:**

There are plenty of bleachers at each court for spectator seating. Bleacher seats are permitted, but no lawn chairs or other outside chairs are allowed in the facility.

#### FOOD/CONCESSIONS:

No outside food, drinks or coolers will be allowed into the facilities. Concessions are sold at the facility.

#### **WARM-UP PROCEDURES:**

Before your *first match*, teams will share the court for 2 mins (please keep balls on your own side). After that each team will then get the entire court for 4 mins (serving must be a part of this time). The team that elects to serve first gets the court first.

\*\*\*If a team plays back-to-back, then there will be NO warmup for that team\*\*\*

#### **AGE SPECIFIC RULES:**

All teams playing in 10-11s or 12s divisions are allowed to use the "step-in line" to serve. The step-in line will be 6'6" into the court. If a player gets 3 serves in a row from the step-in line, they will be asked to move back beyond the end-line until their service turn is ended.



#### POOL-PLAY FORMAT:

In all pools, matches will be best 2 of 3 sets with sets 1 & 2 played to 25 points. If necessary, a 3rd and deciding set will be played to 15 points. All sets have no cap and must be won by 2 points. Pool play will consist of 3, 4, or 5 team pools. Most teams will play 3 matches on Saturday & 2 on Sunday, but a few teams (especially in 5-team pools) might play 4 matches on Saturday or just 2 but play 3 on Sunday. Regardless, all teams will receive a minimum of 5 matches (or 10 sets) for the weekend.

#### TIEBREAKERS:

There will be NO PLAYOFFS during pool play (not even for Gold or Silver). All ties will be solved via the following protocol:

- Match Percentage
- Head-to-head (ONLY used if it is 2-team tiebreaker)
- Set Percentage
- Point Percentage
- Flip a coin

All calculations are viewable on AES online. Please monitor scores as they are updated to be sure this information is accurate throughout the day.

Medals will be given to 1st place and 2nd place in the GOLD bracket of each division only. Commemorative Bag Tags will be given to the 1st place team in the GOLD bracket of each division only.
